### Help Trash Day Go Smoother:

- Set your garbage cart out by 7:00am on your service day.
- Make sure your cart is not more than 5 feet from the road.
- Bagging your garbage will help keep your cart and the city cleaner.
- Large EMPTY boxes may be set next to the can (ie. TV box, appliance box, etc.)
- Remember there is a limit of only 2 extra bags or boxes outside of the trash can. Please be mindful of any animal problems in your area.
- Unacceptable items: Construction materials, bulk items, hazardous chemicals, tires, and yard waste.

### Other Important Information:

- If you need/no longer need an additional trash cart, please contact the water department.
- If you need a cart repaired or replaced, please contact ZTS with the contact info below.
- Like our Facebook page for up to date information on any route delays due to inclement weather or holidays.
- We will be closed on the following holidays:
  - New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day,
  - Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.
  - Routes will run one day later than normal following each holiday.
